



## Safety Alert

### LV-Mounted Flashing/Revolving Amber Lights

#### Incident Description

An employee was recently pulled-over by a regional Queensland police officer and was fined for traveling on a public road with a revolving amber light mounted on a Light Vehicle (LV) without a permit. The light was switched off at the time.

A loss of points is also possible, along with potential repercussions from your site management.

#### Recommendations (QLD Sites)

1. As of March 6<sup>th</sup> 2008, all Queensland-based Klinge LVs with permanently mounted amber revolving/flashing lights for use on the mine site MUST obtain written letter of authority for having the light, from the designated Mine Site Manager.
2. If you do not have or do not wish to obtain a letter of authority ensure that your (magnetic base) light is removed from the vehicle prior to traveling on a public road.
3. Regardless of which state you are in, please ensure that your light is switched off prior to traveling on a public road.
