



Safety Alert #74: Access and Egress from within Tyre Handler Arms

Incident

A tyre service person was exiting from within the tyre handler arms, and whilst ducking under one of the tyre handler arms the tyre service person bumped his head on the tyre handler arm.

Recommendations

1. Before acting review the need to be within the tyre handler arms – ie if you don't have to be there, then do not enter.
2. When positioning the tyre handler, where possible tilt the tyre handler attachment so that one arm is higher than the other and thus allows easier access and egress.
3. Be observant & cautious with your movements – carefully move under the tyre handler arm.
