- Pedestrians cross busy streets between intersections, instead of taking a few extra minutes to walk to lights or a crossing. Crossing a busy street is dangerous and illegal.
- Using the wrong tools or equipment for a job, due to unavailability or because of external pressure to complete a job due and get the machine back into production.
- Working outside of procedures because you think you know a better way or it may take a few minutes off the job!

Performing tasks in the safest way possible, rather than taking short cuts or risks should be seen as a priority in every Klinge workplace, whether that is in the tyre bay or the office. We owe it to ourselves and our team mates to work as safe as possible and if we are unsure....STOP and think about the task and or seek advice from management.
