

# Loading, Unloading and Handling of Tyres

When handling more than one tyre with the tyre handler, only the bottom tyre is secured, the remaining tyres have the potential to fall, as they are unrestrained.

Additionally, handling more than one tyre at a time also has the potential to over load the tyre handler. If personnel are unsure of the weights of tyres/rims/assemblies, the Tyre and Rim Weight Chart contained in SWP-K&C-015 Safety Tyre and Rim Handling and Storage Procedure should always be consulted and a copy of this document contained in each tyre handler on site.

This is applicable to **ALL** tyre sizes.

Please ensure the following Safe Work Procedure is reviewed by all personnel, paying extra attention to page 5 – Tyre Handler point f. as shown below. Once refreshed, please use the attached sign off sheet as acknowledgement of this Safety Tip and also the sign off sheet for the Safe Work Procedure.
