

## FACE SHIELDS

**It is recommended to wear a face shield with a safety helmet when cleaning rim/componentry under the body of a machine.**



When personnel are required to operate rotation or other tooling while working on or under machines it is a requirement that a face shield be worn. If there is the potential of under body or in body "hang-up" falling, then it is recommended that a safety helmet also be worn in conjunction with the face shield. The wearing of a safety helmet is to eliminate the possibility of an injury occurring from "hang-up" falling.

It is therefore important that the face shield being worn on site be designed to enable a safety helmet to be worn. The photo above is an example of a face shield that allows a TSP to also wear a safety helmet.

The face shield below is quite bulky and does not allow a safety helmet to be worn, which exposes a TSP to the risk of injury from hang up or falling debris.
